Day 1

Bangkok – Arrival

Day 2 Damnoen Saduak floating market - Railway Market - Leather Factory - Gems Gallery - Jodd Fairs Market

Morning

Breakfast at the hotel

Early morning departure by road from Bangkok to the garden province of Samut Songkhram in the Mae Klong River delta area. Experience the thrill of Maeklong Train Market folding up and the stalls being packed away in front of your eyes. Explore the market like a local and see the stalls stacked with fruits, vegetables, and seafood. Then proceed to take a unique country market along the railway tracks where a variety of goods are sold and the train travels through bringing people to the market.

Next proceed to Damnoen Saduak Floating Market, the most colorful floating market in the Kingdom.

Enjoy the beautiful sights along the way and witness the day-to-day activities of the Thai people who live on the canals selling their fresh fruits and vegetables from the surrounding villagers farms.

Take a short paddle boat ride through the canals to get the closure feeling of the local people.

Day 3 Chao Phaya River (by across boat)/ Wat Arun/Grand Palace/4 Face Buddha/ Platinum Mall or MBK Mall

Morning

Breakfast at the hotel

Next Explore Chao Phaya River by across boat launch on the picturesque **Chao Phraya River** and canals, or Klongs, to observe the serene family homes and temples along the waterways.

You will pass the famous Royal Barges, excellent samples of Thai craftsmanship and stop at **Wat Arun, often called "the Temple of Dawn**. An ancient temple dating back to the Ayutthaya period with the imposing Khmer-style prang or tower is 104 meters tall with steep stairs with the amazing views of the Chao Phraya River.

Every visitor to Bangkok should see the magnificent buildings within the **Grand Palace** compound to get a feeling of the grandeur architectural style. Since the founding of Bangkok as the Nation's capital by King Rama I, The grand palace has been the major architectural symbol of The Thai Royal family. In the present time, The Royal Family resides at Chitralada Palace while The Grand Palace is used for ceremonial purposes.

- Next Visit The four faced Buddha at the Erawan Shrine, Bangkok has four faces, but it isn't Buddha. It is Lord Brahma who is one of the Trinity of Hindu Gods.
The other two are Lord Vishnu, the sustainer and Lord Siva the destroyer. Brahma is said to be born from a lotus leaf sprouting from the navel of Vishnu.
